Accomplishments – Well dedication in Mosojane, leadership training of 50 leaders from the area. Bibles distributed to leaders without bibles and many students and scripture unions within surrounding schools where rallies were performed. Total bibles distributed 298 Culunga, and 500 English New Testaments. Sports ministry with Kings Foundation, children’s ministry at Mosojane Day care all efforts were targeted at validating Pastor Andrew of new church plant designated at property donated by Momsojane (Freda) for church plant. \$1000 dollars left toward church building.

Tetume – moved on Thursday and began with open market rally and Pastor Ken stayed behind to preach at Tetume Baptist for those coming for revival meetings. Result was miracle in Pastor Bornwell’s life of forgiveness toward his daughter and future son in law. Rally in Tetume SS School 1800 present and most responded to invitation to purity and professing Christ as savior. Rallies in front of supermarket and bars with profession of faith at each venue. Village evangelism In two areas where our people experienced the poor conditions of those with nothing. Many Responding to the gospel, invitation to come back to Tetume Baptist church revival meetings, Several responding to gospel Friday night, Jesus film showed Friday and Saturday night.

Saturday leadership training, new Christian classes and children’s ministry. Rallies that afternoon before returning to church for evening service.

Sunday team moved to Masunga SS School 1200 studentents and many professing Christ and committing to purity, Bo SHedd remained behind with Pastor Bornwell to baptize and preach Sunday.

Lessons learned – continually aware that our enemy tries to divide the team at some point,

This is not necessarily bad as God uses it to grow us and bring us together in prayer. Andrew has matured greatly since October and did a great job. Though Neladi team didn't come prepared, they performed excellently, and were invaluable. Matata was used overtime in translation, driving, and kept a great Christ like calmness about him. Pastor Bornwell must build leadership around him to be able to stay on point and have others fulfil menial task to free him to lead.

Make sure we have all props equipment needed for mission before leaving GBE. Set clearer parameters on team members as to leadership, team protocol, and chain of command.

Steps to be taken/ suggestions – plans to return to continue Mosojane church plant in May 2011, unless Pastor Norman says the schedule won't support it. Plans for Pastor's conference to be in Masunga under Pastor Abraham's leadership who is over Pastor's fellowship in that area.

He and Andrew affirm we can reach many more pastors and church leaders to equip for the churches around the area and tie the network to FTN vision and prepare leadership to follow up. Discipleship materials for new Christians must be included in teaching of leaders to disciple others who come to Christ from the mission.

Will continue to seek funds for church building in Mosojane and pastor's conference in Masunga for 2011. Our desire is community transformation and to extend the reach of OBC under the leadership of Pastor Norman Schaeffer and the elders of OBC.

Other comments – I love working as a partner with OBC, I hope if there is constructive criticism I need to be more effective during a partner mission that OBC will offer leadership to make sure this relationship continues and grows with the vision of OBC.
